 State aforesaid have granted bargained sold released, and by
 these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
 Charles John Stork all that tract or parcel of land situated in the
 County of Greenville and State aforesaid on branch waters of Reedy
 River, about four and one half miles North of Greenville Court House
 se. Beginning at a bush line corner on thence N 30 1/4 W 9.70
 chs to a stone corner on thence N 38 W 6 chs to a stone corner on
 thence N 61 W 2.50 chs to a stake corner of John C Davidson, thence
 N 30 E 6.33 chs to a stake corner thence N 53 E 4 chs to a stake corner
 thence N 34 E 5.50 chs to rock corner, thence N 71 E 7.50 chs to a stake
 corner, thence N 30 E 3.57 chs to a large sweet gum corner, thence
 N 71 E to the line known as the "Tompson Land, thence with said
 lines to the head of a hollow forming a branch line, thence
 down the meanders of said hollow and branch to the beginning corner
 containing One hundred and fifteen acres more or less and bound-
 ed by lands of John C Davidson, Choice lands, A. Nuboy and
 Tompson land. Together with all and singular the rights
 members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
 belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to
 hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
