

A. David, Wilson Hawkins and Mrs G. Guntter. Beginning at a Blk Oak 3x0, on J. A. David's line and running thence with said line S 27 1/2 W 20.67 c to a Blk Oak 3x0 - thence N 89 1/2 W 27.90 c to a stone 3x0 - thence N 1/2 E 9.00 c to a stone 3x0 - thence S 89 1/2 E 17.50 c to a stone 3x0 - thence S 4 1/2 E 18.80 c to a stone 3x0 on an old line - thence N 89 1/2 E 9.00 c to a history
