 it was referred to a special Referee, to report on the various matters embra-
 ced in the pleadings in said cause, and upon the report of said special
 Referee coming in, containing the various recommendations therein

 other things, ordered that Whittier Symmes and Thomas L. Hower be appointed
 trustees, to whom William A. M. Daniel, clerk of the said court, should convey

 purposes, uses and trusts, as set forth and declared in the deeds reported
 by the said Referee; and whereas the said William A. M. Daniel, clerk and
 aforesaid, did convey the lands mentioned in the pleadings to the said
 trustees: Now, therefore, know all men by these presents, that we
 Thomas L. Hower and Whittier Symmes, trustees as aforesaid, by
 virtue of the power conferred upon us in and by the order and
 trust deed aforesaid, upon the written request of the cestui que trust
 herein endorsed, and in performance of our duty as such trustees and
 also in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and thirty one
 Dollars to us paid by W. B. Millwee before the delivery of these pres-
 ents, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these
 presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
 W. B. Millwee all that piece, parcel or lot of land, being parcels
 of the lands above mentioned - situate and lying in the City and
 County of Newville in the State aforesaid, commencing at a stake
 on the Rail Road purchase corner of Marshall & Mauldin's lot
 thence with Marshall & Mauldin's line N 85 1/2 E one hundred and
 twenty feet to a stake thence along Street N 4 1/2 W fifty feet
 to stake thence S 85 1/2 W one hundred and twenty feet to said
 RR purchase thence S 4 1/2 E fifty feet to the beginning corner known
 in Dickson's Plat as lot No 21 also one other lot in the said City and
 State commencing on West Street corner of lot purchased by Whittier Sym-
 mes running with his line S 55 1/2 W one hundred and eight feet
