anywise concern, I, S. J. Douthit Probate Judge of the County of Green-
ville in the said State, send greeting; whereas John M Corrain Administrator
of the Estate of William Corrain deceased, on or about the 6th
day of September in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy
eight did exhibit his complaint in the Court of Probate at Greenville
Court House in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, against
Judy Springfield, Elizabeth Langley, Louisa M Corrain, Sarah Corrain
and Rebecca Corrain And the cause, being at issue before the honorable
Court aforesaid, came on to be heard on the 8th day of October one
thousand eight hundred and seventy eight when the said Court, after
a full hearing thereof, and mature deliberation in the premises, did order
adjudge and decree that the tract of land, belonging to the estate of
William Corrain deceased, hereinafter mentioned and described, should
be sold at public auction, by the Probate Judge of Greenville County,
