waters of Horse Creek waters of Reedy River beginning on an
Ash thence N 12 E 20.50 to a stake 3 x 2 m thence N 85 W 2.00 to a
stake 3 x 2 m thence N 5 E 4.25 to a stake 3 x 2 m thence S 74 1/2 E 8.80
to a stone 3 x 0 m thence S 15 1/2 W 3.00 to a stone 3 x 0 m thence S 88
E 19.25 to a stone 3 x 0 m thence S 5 W 5.00 to a stone 3 x 0 m thence
