I know all men by these presents
that I, Mary J. Garrison of
Greenville County, in the

State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One thousand
Dollars to me in hand paid by Cora L. Howell, (the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged) of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid
have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do
grant bargain sell and release unto the said Cora L. Howell all
that piece parcel and tract of land containing sixty four acres
more or less situate lying and being in Greenville County in the
State aforesaid on Branchy creek of Enore River, adjoining lands
of Abraham Brew, Mrs M. A. McCarter, and Joseph Edwards
beginning at a persimmon tree 3x3x2 nm on Branchy creek
near the bridge and running thence down the meanders of said
creek as a line to the intersection of Edwards Run creek, thence
up the meanders of said Run creek, to a Persimmon tree 3x
nm Mrs M. A. McCarter's corner thence N 62 1/4 W with
said McCarter's line to a Post oak 3x3 nm Joseph Edwards
corner thence S 6 1/4 W 40 chs to a White Oak 3x3 nm in
the fork of a road thence along said road as a line to the
beginning corner. Together with all and singular the
rights, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining,
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said Cora L. Howell her heirs and assigns forever.
And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and

administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the
said premises unto the said Cora L. Howell her heirs and assigns,
against me and my heirs, and all other persons whomsoever lawfully
