consideration of the sum of One hundred and sixty six Dollars and fifty cents of 166.50 to me paid by L Jennings of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said L Jennings a certain tract of land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on both sides of the Ridge Road and on waters of meadow fork a branch of Mush Creek beginning on a stone 3x corner of George Southern lot thence S 5 1/2 W 7.17 chs to a Post Oak 3x thence S 5 1/2 W 11.62 ch to a stone 3x thence S 24 1/2 E 6.72 ch to stone 3x I W McKinney corner thence N 50 E 15.68 ch to a stone thence N 1/2 W 7.35 ch to the beginning corner, and containing eleven and one tenth (11/10) acres more or less; Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining.
