and release unto the Methodist Protestant Church all those
lots of land situate in the City of Greenville in Greenville County
and State aforesaid and in the Eastern part of my lands in
said City fronting on John Street 165 1/4 feet and on cross street
177 feet and bounded on N.E. by R M Pickens lot and on
N.W. by lot no 2 and known on Plat as lots no 5 and 6.
(Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments
and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in anywise
incidental or appertaining unto R M Pickens Henry W Murff
and Samuel Wyatt and their successors or trustees.) To have and to
hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto said Church
for said M P Church; and I do hereby bind myself my heirs execu-
tors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and
singular the said premises for said M P Church against myself
my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming
or to claim the same or any part thereof.

of South Carolina on the waters of Crozer River adjoining the lands
of W. H. Anderson, J. K. White and others and containing two hun-
dred & sixty seven acres more or less being a part of the Simeon
Westmoreland tract of land. Together with all and singular the
rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said pre-
mises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have
and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto
the said Nancy L. Hughes her heirs and assigns forever and
I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said prem-
ises unto the said Nancy L. Hughes her heirs and assigns against
me and my heirs or any other person lawfully claiming or to
claim the same or any part thereof.
