

Pollard and W J West Appraisers appointed in accordance with the act of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, entitled "an act to determine and perpetuate the Homestead" passed on the ninth day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty eight & the re-enactments thereof & amendments thereto to appraise and set off to the Defendant James E Cox in the above stated case, the personal property to which he is entitled under said act, after being duly sworn, have appraised and set off, and by these presents do appraise and set off, unto the said Defendant James E Cox the following property, to wit: one clock, one Bed & Bedding, one looking Glass, one map of U S A, 6 chairs, one trunk, one table, one Bed Stead, one Bible, one History of U.S., one leatboard, one cooking stove & fixtures, one dining table, 2 barrels, one lot of Ware, one lot farming tools &c, one grindstone, one Bellows, one one horse wagon, six head of cattle, one lot of hogs, one Bay horse, one gray mare, six sheep, 80 bushels corn, one lot of Hodge and Cheeks, 450 pounds of Pork, The whole of said property being valued at three hundred and four and 95/100 Dollars. To have and to hold all and singular the property before mentioned unto the said Defendant James E Cox, in accordance with the provisions of the aforesaid act.
