in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released,  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto  
the said Jesse Cunningham a certain piece parcel or tract  
of land containing sixty acres be the same more or less, situate  
in Greenville County, and State aforesaid on branches of Coffee  
Creek, branch waters of Reedy River beginning at stone 37 x  
37 on, thence S 83 1/8 W. 50.70 chs to stone 37 x 37 on, n. on old line,  
thence S 29 1/2 E. 23.17 chs to stone 37 x 37 on, thence N 51 1/2 E. 24.88 chs  
to stone 37 on thence S 50 7/8 E. 23.08 chs to the beginning stone  
37 x 37 on. Together with all and singular the rights, members  
hereditaments and appurtenances, to the said premises  
belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have  
and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the said Jesse Cunningham his heirs and assigns  
forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors  
and administrators to warrant and forever defend all  
and singular the said premises unto the said Jesse Cun-  
ningham his heirs and assigns against myself and my

bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant  
bargain sell and release unto the said Albert A. Pike all  
that lot or parcel of land situate in Greenville County and State  
aforesaid on the West side of the White Horse road about five  
miles West of Greenville Court House beginning at State x of  
Meeting House lot thence along said road to stake x nm  
thence S 84 W 14.50 chs to Rock x nm near branch, thence N 44 1/2  
E. 34 chs to stake x nm thence N 84 E 7.67 chs to the beginning  
corner containing five acres be it the same more or less and  
bounded by lands of said James McPherson, L. Libous and  
Meeting House lot. Together with all and singular the rights  
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises  
belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have  
and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
the said Albert A. Pike his heirs and assigns forever,  
And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors, and admin-  
istrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
the said premises unto the said Albert A. Pike his heirs and  
assigns against one and my heirs, and every other person  
or persons lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or  
any part thereof.
