To Charles Sharp and W H Elliott  
Commissioners of Norfolk County  
in the State of Virginia; greeting;

Know ye that in consideration of your integrity and skill full power is hereby given to you to take probate of the Execution of the deed hereto annexed from William D Thomas to Franklin Cox dated the day of Oct 1879 For this purpose you shall cause one of the subscribing witnesses of the deed aforesaid to appear before you and having administered to him (as you are hereby fully authorized to do) an oath or solemn affirmation according to the form of his religious persuasion that his affidavit is true you shall take under his hand an affidavit that he was personally present and saw William D Thomas and Ella H Thomas his wife sign seal and deliver the deed aforesaid for the uses and intents therein expressed and that he and the other subscribing witness signed their names thereto as witnesses of its due execution which affidavit authenticated under your hands and seals you shall annex to this writ Full power is also given you to take the remuneration of Ella H Thomas wife of William D Thomas of Norfolk in the State of Virginia of her dower in the premises described in the deed hereto annexed conveying a lot of land situate lying and being in the City and County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina and for this purpose you will cause the said Ella H Thomas to appear before you and you will examine her privately and separately apart from all other persons and if upon such examination she shall freely declare that she does freely voluntarily and without any compulsion dread or fear of any person or persons whatsoever renounce release and forever relinquish to Franklin Cox his heirs and assigns all her interest and estate and also all her right and claims of dower of in and to all and singular the premises described and conveyed in the deed aforesaid and having certified under your hands and seals the due execution of this writ (and verified the same by the oath of one of you before some magistrate who is authorized by the laws of your State to administer an oath and whose official signature may be properly authenticated) (You shall carefully return this writ together with your proceedings there
