

to collect all such debts and demands hereby assigned, as may be collectable. 2. And with and out of the proceeds of such sales and collections to pay.

1. To my attorney & a counsel fee of Fifty Dollars, and all other just and reasonable expenses, costs and charges incident to the trust hereby created.
 2. The rents now due my Landlord amounting to something less than ninety Dollars.
 3. The debts due by the firm of Heilhouse & Bacon to sundry persons, amounting, in the aggregate, to about the sum of \$500. and also the debts due by the late firm of Miles & Heilhouse (assigned by Heilhouse & Bacon) to Goodwin & Co and H. Stroud & Co, the exact amount of which is not remembered.
 4. The balance to be divided by the said James G Hawthorne into two equal parts, one equal part thereof to be held by the said James G Hawthorne in trust for the said Arthur W. Bacon his executor administrators or assigns, the other equal part thereof (being the portion of the said Benjamin A Heilhouse) to be applied to the payment of a note, under seal, due by one J. A Miles and the said Benjamin A Heilhouse, to the late J. P Heilhouse, for the sum of Seventeen hundred and twenty nine Dollars, dated the 4th of May 1879.
 5th The residue, if any, of the last mentioned money, to be applied to the payment of all other debts due and owing by the said Benjamin A Heilhouse, and if there remain a surplus, to return the same to the said Benjamin A Heilhouse his executor, administrators or assigns. Provided however, that all those accepting and partaking of the benefits provided in this assignment, shall and well give a full and complete acquittance and discharge of and from any balance of the debt which may remain unsatisfied.
