Known all men by these presents, that I Micajah B Harrison of Alachua County in the State of Florida and formerly of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Fifteen hundred Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Mrs Lucia Harrison of Greenville County in the State the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Mrs Lucia Harrison all my own right's interest (undivided) in the two following described tracts of land. Tract No 1 situate lying and being in Greenville County in the State of South Carolina, on the waters of Reedy River and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a Hickory tree 3x on the bank of the River thence N 5 2/3 E 17 to a Rock thence N 24 E 18, 25 to a Rock 3x thence N 60 W 25, 37 to a Rock thence N 7 1/2 W 15, 40 to a Rock 3x thence S 44 1/2 W 15, 41 to a stake on River bank thence with meanderings of said River to beginning corner said tract containing one hundred and twenty four acres more or less. Tract No 2 situate lying and being in Greenville County in the State aforesaid on the waters of Reedy River and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a Poplar 3x on the bank of the said River thence S 60 W 18, 70 to a Pine 3x on thence S 7 W 8, 50 to a cedar 3x on thence S 40 1/4 E 7, 55 to a Pine 3x on thence S 13 3/4 E 6, 20 to a cedar 3x on thence S 5 1/4 E 11, 90 to a stone 3x on thence N 4 1/2 E 7, 00 to a white Oak 3x on bank of River thence with the meanderings of said River to beginning corner containing seventy two acres more or less. Both of the above tracts constituting what is known as the Mill tract Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
