in the County & State aforesaid together with all & singular  
the rights hereditaments & appurtenances to the same belong-  
ing or in any wise appertaining thereto, to have & to hold all  
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
W H Charles his heirs & assigns forever, and I do hereby  
bind myself my heirs executors & administrators to  
warrant & forever defend all and singular the said premises  
unto the said W H Charles his heirs & assigns against my-  
self my heirs and against every other person whomsoever  
lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

shall come: I Perry D Gilreath  
Sheriff of Greenville County, and

State aforesaid, and greeting: Whereas by virtue of a writ of Fieri  
Facias, issued out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for the County  
of Greenville, dated the nineteenth day of April in the  
year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy  
eight at the suit of N F Burgess & Co to me directed, comma-  
nding me that of the goods and chattels, land and tenements of  
W A Hudson, to levy the sum of Twenty eight \$100 Dollars dam-  
ages and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements  
of the said W A Hudson all that certain piece, parcel and tract  
of land containing one half an acre more or less, situate and  
being in the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, on  
Washington Street in the City of Greenville, beginning at the  
corner of Washington Street and a street running from

the seizure by me made, by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias  
before mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue  
and purchased by Mary B Hammond of the County of Greenv-  
ille in the State of South Carolina for the sum of One  
dollar being the highest sum that was bidden therefor.

Now know ye that I Perry D Gilreath Sheriff aforesaid, by  
virtue of said writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid, to me directed and  
delivered as aforesaid, and by virtue of the statute in such case  
made and provided, and for and in consideration of the said  
sum of One dollar to me in hand paid, or secured to be paid,  
by the said Mary B Hammond the receipt and payment whereof  
I do hereby acknowledged, have granted bargain and sold and  
by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said  
Mary B Hammond her heirs and assigns forever the said  
tract, piece and parcel of land, with its appurtenances, and all the  
estate, right, title and interest which the said W A Hudson of  
right had of in and to the same: To have and to hold the said  
piece, parcel and tract of land, with its appurtenances, unto  
the said Mary B Hammond her heirs and assigns forever  
as fully and absolutely, as I, the said Perry D Gilreath, might  
could or ought to grant, bargain and sell the same, by  
virtue of the statute aforesaid, and the said writ of Fieri  
Facias, or otherwise.
