Douthitt Master as aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and also in consideration of the sum of five hundred Dollars paid me by the said He L Markley the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said He L Markley and his heirs and assigns, all that tract of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, on the Laurens Road, adjoining tract No. 1, 2, 3, and others, and containing seventy two and one fourth acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever, to the said tract of land, belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversions and remainders, rents, issues, and profits thereof, and also all the estate, right, title, interest, dower, possession property, benefit, claim, and demand whatsoever, both at law and in equity, of the said John P Pool, and of all the parties to the said suit, and of all other persons rightfully, claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof, by, from, or under them, or either of them, to have and to hold the said tract of land with its hereditaments, privileges, and appurtenances unto the said He L Markley his heirs and assigns forever.
