Bush of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said No. 9 Bush trustee aforesaid, a certain piece parcel or tract of land containing Four and three fourths acres be the same more or less situated lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid on South side of Piney Mountain adjoining lands of George Croft James Davis and others.
