State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred (800⁰⁰) and fifty five Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by Archibald McMahon of Pickens County in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Archibald McMahon a certain piece parcel or tract of land, situate in Greenville County and State of South Carolina on Golden Grove Creek waters of Saluda River and known as lot No. 3 of the Richardson land, and is described as follows, Beginning at a stone in road on lot No. 4 N 1/2 E 35.00 to a stake originally an Ash thence on Tarrant's land N 48 1/2 W 20.45 to a stone on old line thence on lot No. 2 S 25 3/4 W 39.90 to a stone in the road thence along the road on lots No. 7 & 6 to the beginning containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less and is described more fully in a plat made by J. N. Southern, "and I do hereby bind my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Archibald McMahon his heirs."
