do grant bargain, sell and release, unto the said

interest in a lane or pass way on the East side of
said M. G. DeCaups house lot containing 1770
square feet being half interest in said lane or
pass way commencing on College at thence along
said M. G. DeCaups line N 48 E 295 feet to
stake corner thence S 69 E 6 feet to stake corner
thence S 44 W 295 feet to stake on said college

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square feet being half interest in said lane or
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thence S 44 W 295 feet to stake on said college

at thence to the beginning corner N 69 W 6 feet bounded
