and State aforesaid, send greeting: whereas by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias, issued out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for the County of Greenville, tested the fifth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight at the suit of John W Stokes to me directed, commanding me that of the goods and chattels, lands and tenements of Perry W Robertson to levy the sum of Forty two dollars damages and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Perry W Robertson all that certain piece parcel and tract of land, containing sixty eight acres more or less, situate and being in the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, adjoining lands of P G Fowler David Taylor and others, and whereas the said premises, with their appurtenances, since the seizure by me made, by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue, and purchased by Mary P Robertson of the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina for the sum of Five hundred and ten Dollars being the highest sum that was bidder therefor. Mary P Robertson the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Mary P Robertson her heirs and assigns forever, the said tract, piece and parcel of land, with its appurtenances, and all the estate right, title and interest, which the said Perry W Robertson of right had, of, in and to the same: To have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land, with its appurtenances, unto the said Mary P Robertson her heirs and assigns forever, as fully and absolutely, as I the said Perry D Gilreath might could or ought to grant bargain and sell the same, by virtue of the statute aforesaid, and the said writ of Fieri Facias, or otherwise.
