Westmoreland all that certain piece parcel or tract of land situated on Kinder Creek about 16 miles N. E. of Greenville C. H. in the County and State aforesaid being the same as was set off to me as my dower in the land of my deceased husband Simon R. Westmoreland I James B. Westmoreland party of the second part for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid do hereby agree and bind myself to cultivate the said land in a farmer like manner to pay the yearly tax on the same to one person and give the said Elizabeth Westmoreland such comfort

of this lease and to give the said Elizabeth Westmoreland peaceable and quiet possession of the said land unless another and further agreement is entered into between us.
