Koxes estate Simon Bates and Geo H Goodwin con-
taining one hundred acres more or less known as
the John Shelton tract together with all and singular
the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances
to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident
or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singu-
lar the premises before mentioned unto the said
William Bridwell his heirs and assigns forever
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and
administrators to warrant and forever defend all
and singular the said premises unto the said William
Bridwell his heirs and assigns, against me and my
heirs, and all other persons lawfully claiming, or to
claim the same, or any part thereof.

Agreement

The State of South Carolina
Whereas R R Ashbery of
the City and County
of Greenville in said
State has this day executed to J Q Donaldson
and John H Maxwell his bond in the penal sum of Ten
thousand Dollars conditioned for the payment of the sum
of five thousand eight hundred and fifty dollars in seventy
eight equal monthly instalments of seventy five dollars
each one half thereof to the said J Q Donaldson and one
fourth each to the said C H Judson and John H Maxwell
the same being for stock in the Greenville Gas Light & Ice
Company owned by the said J Q Donaldson C H Judson &
John H Maxwell and by them this day bargained to
the said R R Ashbery now therefore we the said J Q Donal-
dson C H Judson and John H Maxwell in consideration
of the premises and of said bond and in pursuance of the
bargain aforesaid do hereby covenant and agree to and
with the said R R Ashbery to assign transfer and set
over to him at the expiration of every twelve months
succeeding the date hereof without warranty save against
ourselves our heirs executors and administrators such
proportion of said stock as he shall during the said
twelve months have paid us for, until the whole of the
stock so by us owned shall have been assigned transferred
and set over to him and we do furthermore covenant
and agree to and with the said R R Ashbery to allow
him to anticipate said monthly payments and to allow
him a discount at the rate of fourteen per centum
per annum on all payments anticipated
