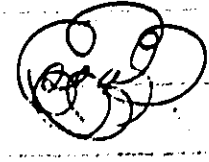

grant bargain sell and release unto the said Samuel
Williams one piece parcel or lot of land about the mes-
sorate limits of the City of Greenville S. C. and bounded
as follows commencing at a stake on Williams St Wash
Blosser corner running with said Street N 7 1/2 W 100
feet thence S 12 1/2 W 202 ft to stake on thence S 12 1/2 E
100 ft to Wash Blosser corner thence with his line
202 feet to the beginning corner on Williams St
Together with all and singular the right's members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said prem-
ises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining
To have and to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said Samuel Williams his heirs
and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself
my heirs executors and administrators to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said prem-
ises unto the said Samuel Williams his heirs and
assigns against me and my heirs and every other

person whomsoever lawfully claiming: or to claim the same
or any part thereof.
