State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Nancy Harrison all that tract piece or parcel of land situated in the County and State aforesaid on waters of South Oaulett River beginning on a Rock thence to a Spanish on the old line thence nearly South to Mill Road to a Rock thence with the Mill Road to a Rock on the conditional line thence with the conditional line to the beginning Rock corner containing twenty five (25) acres more or less this being part of the old tract of land laid off by Jacob Bellew to Isaac Bellew together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining; To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Nancy Harrison her heirs and assigns forever. and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Nancy Harrison her heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
