H. Turbyfield and others, and containing two hundred acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, manors, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever, to the said tract of land belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and the reversions and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, and also all the estate, right, title, interest, share, portion, property, benefit, claim and demand whatsoever, both at law and in equity, of the said Nancy Harrison deceased and of all the parties to the said deed and of all their persons, rightfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof, by force or otherwise, with or without them, he, his heirs and assigns
