ents, that I William M

Tilly William ^{his} M Tilly in the State aforesaid, Greenville
County in consideration of the sum of Two hundred (200⁰⁰)
Dollars to me paid by Allen Gosnell Wilborn Gosnell
President Davis Gosnell in the State aforesaid
Greenville County have granted bargained sold and
released and by these presents do grant bargain sell
and release unto the said Allen Gosnell a certain lot
piece or tract of land lying being and situate in Greenville
County State aforesaid, containing sixteen acres
more or less on North side of Meadow Fork of Neesh
Creek branch waters of South Tyger River beginning
at a black gum (gone) an agreed corner on T. Benson
and Catherine Compton's line thence North with said
line to a white Oak an agreed corner thence East
to a stake on Catherine Compton's and T. Benson's
line an agreed corner thence South West to a
stake on West corner of the old field W.D. McKinnis
and T. Benson's and Cath. Compton's corner
thence West with Mill path to beginning corner.
Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditam-
ents and appurtenances to the said premises belonging,
or in anywise incident or appertaining: To have and
to hold all and singular the said premises before menti-
oned unto the said Allen Gosnell, Wilborn Gosnell
President Davis Gosnell his heirs and assigns forever
And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and
administrators, to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said premises unto the said
Allen Gosnell his Wilborn Gosnell, General Davis
Gosnell heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs
and all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim
the same, or any part thereof.
