Earle all that piece parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid at Greens Station, and known in the survey made by H. P. Johnson as lot No. 5 bounded on the South by the Public Square 112 feet front, on the East by lot No. 4 now the property of W. L. Marchant, and running back 200 feet, on the North by lot No. 14 now the property of Pascal Hawkins, 112 feet on the West by lot No. 6 bid off at the sale by J. W.
