by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release, unto  
the said Milly Thompson all that piece parcel and lot  
of land situate lying and being in the County of  
Greenville and State aforesaid, on the branch waters  
of Middle Saluda River containing ten acres more  
or less and having the following lines metes & bounds, to  
wit: Beginning at Red Oak 87 3/4 n. m. dead and extending  
along Cleaveland's line S 49 1/2 W. 15. 67 chs to Dog Wood 37  
n. m. thence S 60 7/10 E - chs to stake 87 n. m. thence N 00  
E 9. 60 chs to Post Oak 87 3/4 n. m. thence N 23 1/4 E 4. 49 chs  
to stake 87 in Road; thence N 57 1/2 W 4. 74 chs to Red Oak  
beginning point adjoining lands of Cleaveland Henry  
Springfield and others - Together with all and sing-  
ular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurten-  
ances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise  
incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and sing-
