ents, that E. A. Kelly of the
County of Greenville in the

State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum
of Five Dollars (and of natural love and affection)
to me paid by M. Ida Humphreys of the County
of Greenville in the State aforesaid, have granted
bargained sold and released, and by these presents do
grant bargain sell and release unto the said M. Ida
Humphreys all that tract of land situate lying and
being in the County and State aforesaid, on waters
of North Saluda River, adjoining lands of Estate of
Michael Whitmore, & W. Keeler and others. Beginning
at the mouth of the Spring branch on said river, thence
up said branch to the head, it being at Landreth's Spring
thence to the line of the old John Kelly tract to a stone
corner on the old road, thence S 50° E. to the Public road
thence along said road to Keeler's mill tract, thence
along Keeler's line to an Ash on said River, thence
up said river to the beginning corner, and con-
taining One Hundred acres, more or less.

Together with all and singular the rights members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said prem-
ises belonging, or in anywise incident or apper-
taining. To have and to hold, all and singular
the said premises before mentioned unto the said
M. Ida Humphreys her heirs and assigns forever,
and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs executors
and administrators to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said premises unto the said
M. Ida Humphreys her heirs and assigns against
me and my heirs, and every other person whomsoever
lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part
thereof.

before the sealing of these presents, by Thomas S. Glenn of
Greenville County in the State aforesaid (the receipt where-
of is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold
and released, and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the said Thomas S. Glenn all
that tract piece or parcel of land situate lying and
being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid
about one and one fourth miles from Greenville
Court House on the North side of the Laurens Road
and known as part of tract of No. 7 in the survey of W. A.
Henderson of the Hammond's Estate. Being at a stake & c. on
said Laurens Road thence S 57 1/4° W 35.20 chs. to a Rock
& c. thence N 28° W 15 chs. to a Rock & c. thence N 46 1/4° E 12.50
chs. to a stake & c. in gully thence S 48 1/2° E 3 chs. to a
stake & c. near big Spring thence N 3 1/2° E 7 chs. to a stake
& c. on said Laurens Road thence S 72 1/2° E 45.9 chs. to
angle thence S 78 1/2° E 10.30 chs. to angle thence S 58 1/2° E 8 chs.
to the beginning containing forty seven 1/2 acres be-
ing the same more or less and bounded by lands of said
Thomas S. Glenn land known as the Leburne and to the
