that I John J Bruce of Greenville  
County in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars  
to me paid by William J Bruce in the State aforesaid  
have granted bargained sold and released and by  
these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto  
the said William J Bruce all my undivided one (1/5)  
fifth interest in all that certain piece or parcel and tract  
of land situate lying and being in Greenville County  
and State aforesaid containing one hundred and  
forty two (142) Acres more or less adjoining lands  
of the Estate of J E Ware Roberts John Cooley Woodson  
others and known as the old horsestead of  
Robert Bruce decd. Together with all and singular  
the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident  
or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular  
the said premises before mentioned unto the said  
William J Bruce his heirs and assigns forever  
And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors  
and administrators to warrant and forever defend  
all and singular the said premises unto the said  
William J Bruce his heirs and assigns against me  
and my heirs & every other person whatsoever lawfully  
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof  
Witness my hand and seal this 24<sup>th</sup> day of May in the  
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
eighty and in the one hundred and fourth year of  
the Sovereignty and Independence of the United  
States of America.

shall come or be made known

or whom the same may in anywise concern I S. J. Douthick  
Master of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid  
send greeting: whereas a petition was filed in the  
Probate Court for said State and County on the 20<sup>th</sup>  
day of October 1875 by Micajah O Harrison and  
others against Thomas G Harrison and Anna M  
Harrison to partition the real estate of Nancy Harrison  
deceased and whereas the said real estate was partially  
partitioned under said proceedings and whereas it  
has since been decided by the Supreme Court that  
the Probate Court was without jurisdiction in such  
cases and whereas it became necessary to institute pro-  
ceedings in the Court of Common Pleas for the  
State and County aforesaid to confirm the said part-  
ition and whereas a complaint was filed in said  
Court of Common Pleas on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October 1879  
by Micajah O Harrison against James O Harrison  
and others and upon the hearing of said cause the  
said Court amongst other things did order and
