of Six hundred Dollars to me in hand paid at and  
before the sealing of these presents, by O. M. Snow of  
Greenville County in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and  
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell  
and released unto the said O. M. Snow a certain  
piece parcel or tract of land containing eighty  
five acres be the same more or less situated in  
Greenville County and State aforesaid, on Peter Man-  
ch waters of Enoree River, Belonging to Thos. O. Snow  
Sen deceased, Being a part of the Parkdale Snow  
Tract of land deeded to the said Thos. O. Snow  
deceased in the year 1854, Beginning at a chestnut on the  
Ridge Road thence N 23 E 25.50 ch to chestnut 2 x 0.75  
John R. Snow deceased corner a sewer made for  
convenience, thence Nearly North 20.00 ch to a Pencil-  
now on North side of said Branch 3 x 0.75 thence  
N 35 1/2 W 6.67 ch to Rock D. J. Smith corner 3 x 0.75  
thence S 52 W 28.00 ch along said D. J. Smith line  
to Rock on Ridge Road thence down the meandering  
of said Road to the beginning chestnut, Reference to a  
Plot hereto annexed will more fully appear,  
Together with all and singular the rights incident  
hereto and appertaining to the said premises  
belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining  
thereto and to hold all and singular the said

in the named tract of land, and I do hereby bind my-

claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof,
