Burbage of said County and State, have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Williams W. Gilreath and Samuel P. Burbage all those certain pieces parcels and tracts of land situate lying and being in said County and State, and having the following lines, metes and bounds to wit: Tract No. 1 containing five hundred and twenty one acres more or less being the same tract which was conveyed to the said Nicholas F. Burgess by P. B. Duncans, Executor of the Will of Laurence P. Mott deceased by Deed of conveyance bearing date the fourth day of March A.D. 1863 and having such lines metes and bounds as are shown on a plat of the same (hereto attached) made by James K. Dickson Esq. D.S. bearing date 31st March 1863. to which reference is hereby made and known as the Brooks Place.
