 in Greenville County and State aforesaid on the head
 waters of Mc Cooks Beaver dam creek waters of middle
 Tiger River beginning on Baum branch on a stake
 thence across the Jordan road to double chestnut
 thence with William Mitchell's line to J. D. Dills corner
 a stone West of the factory Road thence to Columbus
 Mills corner on the East side of the factory Road
 thence up the said road to a Oak and stump on
 the North side of the Jordan road thence up the
 Jordan road to a Oak and stump on the South side of
