these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
the said A. M. Watson a certain tract piece or parcel
of land lying and being situate in Greenville County
in the State aforesaid on some small branches waters
of middle fork of Saluda River containing one hundred
and twenty six (126) acres more or less and was
conveyed to me by J. L. Cox the 23rd day of February
A.D. 1877 and runs as follows beginning at a forked
