 ents, by Frank M. Trimmier in the State aforesaid, (the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained
 sold and released, and by these presents do grant
 bargain sell and release unto the said J. M. Trimmier
 a certain parcel or tract of land lying and being in
 the County and State aforesaid, on waters of Beaver
 Dam Creek and on N. side of the State Road beginning
 at P. O. corner of Langley's and Parker land on South
 side of 1st creek running with Langley's line N 63 E
 cross 1st creek to Red Oak 3 x N. M. 12.25 chs thence S Eastward
 75.6 ft to Pine corner between Francis and Thomas Edwards
 on East side of 1st Road, thence with 1st Road S 19 W 6.15
 chs to bend in Road thence S 26 W 19 chs (less 2.25 ft) to
 corner on white oak East side of Road thence with
 Mr. Parkers line to the beginning corner. This
 line runs S 63 E from P. O. corner to 1st white oak
 corner. Together with all and singular the right
