Freeman all that tract, part, or piece of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, about five miles West of Greenville Court House, on the West side of the White Horse Road, Beginning at a stake & N. on said road thence N 71 W 7.60 chs along said road to a stake & N. thence S 73 W 28.30 chs to a stake & N. in the old road line, thence S 33 E 7.75 chs to a stake & N. thence N 73 E 24.50 chs to the beginning corner, containing twenty acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of said Howard, James McPherson on the South and North and said White Horse Road, and more particularly known by a survey made by G. P. Johnson Nov. 14th 1880 Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances, to the said premises, belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
