West his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William J. West his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
