B. F. Few	Lease	This agreement made between B. F. Few of Greenville County and State of South Carolina and J. H. Knight, Noah Knight and William Knight of the same place witnesseth that the said B. F. Few agrees on his part to rent to the said J. H. Knight, Noah Knight and William Knight a certain plantation known as the Alfred Gilmore place, viz. all the land now in cultivation on said place with the privilege of taking in all that has been cultivated on the west side of the Greenville road north of Quack Horn branch for the term of five years consecutively. The said J. H. Knight, Noah Knight and William Knight agree on their part severally and individually to keep the house from leaking do needful ditching on branch to keep it from washing also the necessary ditching on hillsides to protect them from washing, and pay to the said B. F. Few three four hundred and fifty (450) lbs Bales of Good middling cotton annually for the term of five years to be paid as follows one bale 1 st Oct, 1 bale 15 th Oct and 1 bale 1 st Nov of each year either party failing to comply with his part of this obligation shall be bound to the other party in a bond of three hundred Dollars and any and all property they may possess Real or personal shall be bound for the payment of the above bond unless this contract should be dissolved by mutual consent then this obligation shall be null and void, otherwise it shall remain in full force and virtue.	25
