To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said George Straight and his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises, unto the said George Straight and his heirs and assigns against myself my and heirs and every other person who or whoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
