Jenkins of Kershaw County in the State aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien and release unto the said Mary O. Jenkins a certain tract or parcel of land situate and being in Kershaw County, in the State aforesaid, and both sides of South Tupper River beginning at a Post Oak 34 and side of old mill race and goes N 61.0.50 to a Red Oak 34 thence N 70.6.10 to a Crab 34 on the Bank of South Tupper River thence down the meander of said River to a Gum 34 about 880 chs below the mouth of Beaverdam creek thence N 88.6.14.20 crossing the River to a Birch 34 and thence N 27.7.13.20 to a large Pine 34 34 thence N 2 1/2 E 36.44 to a Post Oak 34 34 thence W 37 E 17.8.5 to a Stone 34 thence N 47 W 28.33 to a stone 34 in a branch thence down said branch unto the meander to Red Oak 34 at J. P. Rives corner thence S 44.4 W 30.90 to the beginning containing according to Original deed or Two hundred and twenty acres more or less.
