Whereas amongst other things it was alleged that the Plaintiff Whitman Symmes was entitled to one fifth interest in the lands previously conveyed by William A. McDaniel (deceased) of said County to Thomas B. Grove & Whitman Symmes, Trustees and whereas upon the said cause being heard at the April Term of the Court of Common Pleas for Greenville County, which was in the year A. D. 1879 it was ordered on the 19th day of July A. D. 1879 amongst other things ordered that Thomas B. Grove and Whitman Symmes Trustees as well as Greenville at public outcry & after due advertisement the lots of land mentioned in the said Deed and also previously sold by them and others by virtue of the power conferred upon them in and by the order aforesaid and in performance of duties as directed by said order after having duly advertised the lot or parcel of land hereinafter described for sale by public outcry on the 6th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty - the said Trustees did then openly and publicly sell and dispose of said lot or parcel of land below described unto J. B. Mackley for one hundred and twenty nine dollars & 20c being at that price the highest bid for the same. Now therefore know all men by these presents that Thomas B. Grove & Whitman Symmes Trustees as aforesaid by virtue of the power conferred upon me by the order and also in consideration of the said sum of one hundred & seventy nine dollars to us paid by J. B. Mackley before the delivery of these presents have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said J. B. Mackley all that piece parcel or lot of land being a parcel of the lands above mentioned and lying in the County of Greenville
