 res more or less Beginning on the Camp Branch at Daniel Bellevue line on a stake thence nearly East down said to the fork of the branches thence nearly West to a chestnut oak corner thence nearly North to a Hickory near the Sug Road thence West with the said Road to a chestnut oak near the old Still House thence nearly West to a chestnut thence nearly South with Daniels Bellevue line to the beginning corner Together with all and singular the rights Members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or apper-
 taining to have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mention unto the said Wilborn Howard his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises
