S. Shipp and containing one hundred and forty seven acres more or less being the tract of land conveyed to me by Mrs C. Gable by deed dated 21st June 1875. Also all that tract of land containing ninety one and one fourth acres more or less situate lying and being in Keweenaw County in the State of Wisconsin about ten and one half miles from Keweenaw Co. It being the tract of land conveyed to me by W. D. Lafon by deed dated 31st December 1880 to which deed reference is hereby made and for a full and
