 in reference to a Trust Deed that a suitable Trust Deed
 be reported together with some suitable persons or per-
 sons to act as Trustees or Trustees, and whereas upon
 the said Cause being heard on the 17th day of June A.D.
 1874, it was referred to a Special Referee to report
 on the various matters contained in the pleadings
 in said Cause, and upon the report of said Spe-
 cial Referee coming in, containing the various
 recommendations therein made, and set forth it
 was on the 7th day of August A.D. 1874, amongst
 other things, ordered that Whitener Symmes and
 Thomas G. Gower be appointed Trustees to whom
 William A. McDaniel be appointed Trustee to whom
 should convey the said lands, to have and to use
 the same to for and upon the purposes, uses,
 and trusts as set forth and declared in the Deed
 reported by the said Referee, and whereas the
 said William A. McDaniel, being as aforesaid
 did convey the lands mentioned in the plead-
 ings to the said Trustees, they therefore have
 all men by these Presents, that we, Thomas G.
 Gower, Whitener Symmes, Trustees as aforesaid
 by virtue of the former Confession upon us in &
 by the order and Trust Deed aforesaid, upon
 the written request of the certain new Trust
 now undressed and in performance of our duty as
 such Trustees and also in accordance with the
