sell and release unto the said R. P. Barnett all
that parcel or tract of land lying and being in the
State and County aforesaid on Pacolette River and
Astor Daleus Mill Creek and bounded by lands as
follows: E by lands of Tom Reid N by Lewis Pierce
and Astor Daleus W by Francis and James Gosnell
and S by Jack Bruce being a part of the Whitten
old tract beginning on a large Rock near the ford
of Pacolette River on the Road from James Gosnell to
John Reid's in thence N 5 55 50 to a stone in thence
N 46 1/2 W 18 57 to a stone in thence S 88 W 5 50 to a che-
