Ligon all that piece parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid on Beverdam and Mountain Creek branches also of Saluda River and bounded by lands of Robert M. Clay J. Henry Stokes John Lowley and others being the same tract of land sold by me to Abner Davis on the 29th day of March 1875 and subsequently recovered to me by him the same containing seventy seven acres more or less together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Annie L. Ligon during her natural life and at her death to such child or children of hers as she may leave living at the time of her death and in case she die without leaving a child or children living at the time of her death then the said premises shall revert to my estate and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Annie L. Ligon during her natural life and at her death to such child or children as maybe then living against myself and my heirs and all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
