State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of five thousand and five hundred Dollars to me paid by J. O. Wingo and Mother of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said J. O. Wingo and Brother, the following tracts or parcels of land, one conveyed to Lewis Cockrill by Joseph J. Lamb by deed dated 7th September 1854 calling for 22 6/4 acres from which is to be deducted all that part of this tract lying on the west side of middle Syger; also one tract for 52 acres 2 Rods and 10 poles conveyed to said Lewis Cockrill by deed dated 2nd November 1856; also one other tract containing 48 acres conveyed to said Lewis Cockrill by Nancy Smith by deed dated 15th October 1857, all these tracts of land are situated in Greenville County, State aforesaid, on the East side of middle Syger, and for a more particular description of the above mentioned tracts reference is made to the deeds above mentioned which said Lewis Cockrill incorporated and made part of deed, dated 27th January 1854 conveying all above described land to me. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
