

Bradley in regard to the boundary lines of said tract of land: the said William E Earle claiming title to thirty seven acres thereof, and whereas by an agreement entered into between the said William E Earle and William A Bradley and Minerva Bradley the Executor and Executrix aforesaid, bearing date the tenth day of February 1880 it was submitted to J Newton Southern Surveyor, as arbitrator, to go upon the land and arbitrate, award, order, judge and determine of and concerning the same; and whereas the said J Newton Southern, in pursuance of said agreement, did go upon said lands and did locate the boundary lines thereof and did award to the said Executor and Executrix the thirty seven acres of said tract claimed by them, and in the possession of said William E Earle, as well as appear by his award and plat bearing date the tenth day of March 1880 hereto annexed and forming a part hereof; and whereas the said Executor and Executrix, as such have no interest in said premises, Now therefore, I the said William E Earle in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar to me paid by the parties hereinafter mentioned, and for the purpose of effectuating the agreement aforesaid, and to assist in carrying out the terms of the will of the said Curtis Bradley, have remised, released and forever quitclaimed, and by these presents do remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said Minerva Bradley, the widow and William A Bradley for himself and as trustee of Mary Gilreath, and Joseph Bradley, Arnoldus Bradley, Nancy Bradley and Elizabeth Bates, the children heirs at law of the said Curtis Bradley and devisees under his said will (to each such interest as is devised by said will) all that certain piece or parcel of land on the Northern side of Carr's mountain in said County of Greenville, containing thirty seven

acres, granted to Thomas Meadows on the eighth day of February 1821 and having such shape and boundaries as are represented on the said plat of J N Southern and contained within the blue space delineated on said plat, together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Minerva Bradley, William A Bradley, Joseph Bradley, Arnoldus Bradley, Nancy Bradley and Elizabeth Bates, their heirs and assigns forever, according to the terms and for the purposes of the will of the said Curtis Bradley.
