unto the said Jonathan Gary his heirs and assigns all those pieces parcels or tracts of land situate on Edwidge in County of Greenville and State aforesaid on branches of our River Creek waters of Carver River adjoining lands of Thomas Goldsmith Robert Boyson William Gilbert and others containing seventy eight half acres more or less being tract of land purchased by Jonathan Gary from John W. P. Saulk by deed bearing date Nov. 14<sup>th</sup> 1860 and by him conveyed to me also one other tract of land in said County and State on Rabun Creek waters of Reddy River bounded lands Robert West W. Gilbert & Cornelius and Stephen Vaughn being tract conveyed by Jonathan Gary by Thomas C. Harrison on 11<sup>th</sup> day of July 1852<sup>nd</sup> by him to me containing forty acres & one quarter acres more or less one other tract in said County on the head waters of Rabun Creek waters of Reddy River containing two hundred and thirty eight acres more or less bounded by lands of Mrs Frances West Jonathan Gary Wm Howard and Mrs M. C. Sumpston conveyed to Jonathan Gary by John S. Hammond by deed 26<sup>th</sup> March 1875 and by him to me also one other tract in said County containing seven acres more or less which is described in a plat attached to a deed of same from S. M. Harrison and M. J. Harrison to J. B. Chesterfield and Jonathan Gary bearing date 5<sup>th</sup> April 1864 the above tract of land being the same conveyed to me by Jonathan Gary by deed bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> day of December 1877 and to which deed reference is heretofore for a more full description of said tracts of land

Together with all and singular the rights appurtenances and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Jonathan Gary his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend the said premises
