Twenty third day of September in the year of
 our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
 eighty between Mrs Ida F. Harris formerly
 Ida F. Rowland of the one part and James R.
 Brown of the County of Cherokee and State
 of Georgia of the other part, witnesseth that
 the said Ida F. Harris for and in consideration
 of the sum of one hundred and twenty five

James R. Brown at and before the sealing and deliv-
 ery of these presents the receipt whereof has been
 hath granted bargain sold and conveyed and by
 these presents doth grant bargain sell and convey
 unto the said James R. Brown his heirs and as-
 signs forever the following described lands to
 wit: one undivided eighth part of a tract of land
 formally owned by Mrs Mary W. Lewis grand
 mother of the said Ida F. Harris first husband
 and being in Greenville County and State of South
 Carolina and being on the waters of Creek in
 said County and bounded on the East South and
 West by the lands of Mrs Mary Cleveland and her
 daughter and on the North by the land of Mr
 Dugies and being the place where the said Mary
 W. Lewis is buried, and containing some
 three hundred and fifty acres more or less
 and having been will'd by the said Mary W.
 Lewis to with her other property to her two
 children Dr John W. Lewis and Francis F.
 Rowland mother of the said Ida F. Harris
 first husband and on the death of the said
 Francis F. Rowland her part was inherited or
 went under the said will to four of the said
 Francis children of which John L. Rowland the
 said Idas first husband was one, and at his death
 the same was inherited by the said Ida and her
 daughter Annie, and at the said Annie's death her
 part went to the said Ida to have and to hold the
