Cannon of Spartanburg County in the State aforesaid, I have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Harvey L. Cannon a certain piece parcel or lot of land known as lots No 7 & 8 as surveyed by James K. Dickson for W. A. Hill December 15th 1880 Beginning on the North west corner of Emma and New Street and running S 15 1/2 W two hundred feet to a stone & thence S 74 1/2 E two hundred feet to a stone & thence N 15 1/2 E two hundred feet to a stone & thence with Emma Street N 74 1/2 W two hundred feet to the beginning containing one city acre more or less Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Harvey L. Cannon his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Harvey L. Cannon his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs or any other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
